- ◆ Free skate rental for class.
- ◆ Ice House Class Card with 8 free public skate sessions, skate rental not included. \$3 public admission after all 8 sessions are used, skate rental not included *during weekend sessions*.
- ◆ Three make-up class opportunities, which must be taken by the end of the current semester on the alternate class day. No more than 8 classes may be taken in the term.
- ◆ \$0.25 soda drinks in eatery for student only with Class Card.
- ◆ 10% off regularly priced merchandise in the Pro Shop with Class Card.
- ◆ Membership with US Figure Skating Basic Skills program along with Basic Skills progress book (given once) and participation badge (given annually).
- ◆ Sports Accident Insurance.

Important Information:

- ◆ Dress warmly in layers. Wear gloves or mittens and only 1 pair of long socks.
- ◆ Arrive at least 15 minutes early & present your class card to the Learn to Skate table attendant.
- ◆ Proceed to skate rental to obtain **hockey** skates.
- ◆ Skates should fit snugly & be tied tightly from the toe up.
- ◆ Hockey equipment is not required, but safety helmets are strongly recommended for Hockey 1 students.
- ◆ All elements will be taught without a stick or puck as proper skating technique is the primary focus.
