

Now Enrolling for Spring 2010 US Figure Skating Basic Skills Classes!

8 Classes for \$114! \$10 discount through Feb 27th!

Classes held Tuesdays (March 2nd - April 27th) OR Saturdays (March 6th - May 1st)

No classes on the following dates: Tuesday, March 30th & Saturday, April 3rd due to Spring Break.

These classes are scheduled days off and therefore not included in tuition. The spring term is 8 classes over 9 weeks.



Student Benefits:

- ◆ Eight Basic 1-8, Freeskate &/or Adult classes for \$114.00.
- ◆ Eight Snowplow classes for \$90.00. Snowplow tuition is reduced as practice ice is not offered for skaters at this beginner level since the focus is on class time.
- ◆ 30 minute lesson once a week (either Tuesday OR Saturday).
- ◆ Two make-up class opportunities per semester.
- ◆ Free skate rental for class.
- ◆ Ice House Class Card with 8 free public skate sessions, *skate rental not included*. \$3 public admission after all 8 sessions are used, *skate rental not included during weekend sessions*.
- ◆ \$0.25 soda drinks in eatery & 10% off regularly priced merchandise in the Pro Shop for student only with Class Card.
- ◆ US Figure Skating Basic Skills book with stickers, Basic Skills member patch and year patch.
- ◆ Sports accident insurance.
- ◆ Class Card & benefits expire at end of enrolled term.
- ◆ Refunds (less \$20 administrative fee), for classes not taken, must be requested to Skating Director by week 3. Class card must be forfeited in conjunction with a refund request.

Important Information:

- ◆ Skating Director reserves the right to combine or cancel classes based on attendance levels.
- ◆ If only one student attends a class, this student will receive a 20-minute lesson (instead of 30 minutes) as this is a private lesson. At the conclusion of the 20-minute lesson, the skater may remain on the ice in their designated class space and practice on their own.
- ◆ All first time enrollees 4 and 5 years old **must** enroll for Snowplow class. All first time enrollees ages 6 and up **must** register for Basic 1. Skaters 15 and up should register for the Adult Workshop.
- ◆ Dress warmly in layers. Wear gloves or mittens and only 1 pair of *long* socks. Students should use figure skates that fit snugly and are tied or fastened tightly from the toe up.
- ◆ Arrive 15 minutes early and present your class card each and every week at the Learn to Skate check-in table located in the front lobby, in order to be admitted to classes. A Class Card, with intact make-up “punches,” must be presented to the Learn to Skate table attendant in order to be admitted for make-up classes. A maximum of 8 classes may be taken.
- ◆ After presenting Class Card to Learn to Skate desk for class or make-up, please proceed to the skate rental counter to obtain skates.
- ◆ Snowplow skaters meet OFF-ICE in front of skate rental counter for the first few classes of semester.
- ◆ Practice ice (open to skaters **enrolled** in Basic 1 & higher) is unsupervised practice time for Learn to Skate participants **ONLY**. Making holes in the ice, spirals, camel spins and horseplay are not permitted.

Class Offerings:

Snowplow Sam classes are for our youngest skaters ages 4 & 5. Skaters who pass all 3 Snowplow Sam levels AND demonstrate the emotional and intellectual maturity necessary for the Youth Basic Series, may progress on to Basic 1.

* Please keep in mind that Greensboro Ice House Freeskate and Adult courses are categorized as “Workshops” meaning that several levels are combined within each of those classes with students focusing on a variety of skills. Within the Workshop environment, instructors rotate amongst pupils providing instruction to small groups or individuals while others work independently. Students progress at their own rate through the specific skills of the particular Freeskate or Adult level in which they are working.
