What is the objective of the Basic Skills Synchronized Skating Class?

The purpose of Synchro 1-4 is to introduce Basic Skills students to the fundamental skills of synchronized skating. Skaters will incorporate maneuvers taken from the Basic 1-8 levels, execute those skills in team formation ~ which will strengthen and improve overall skating ability ~ as well as add the excitement, camaraderie and fun of skating in unison with friends! Students will learn line formations such as blocks and intersections and will advance to wheels and circles, as skills progress. Skaters passing through Synchro 4 will be eligible to advance to a Basic Skills Beginner Team with the goal of competing locally to a choreographed program complete with great music and awesome costumes!

Who is eligible to participate in the Basic Skills Synchronized Skating Class?

Skaters 14 and under, who have passed Basic 3 and up. Learn to Skate and private lesson Basic Skills skaters who are Basic 3 through Freeskate are welcome and encouraged to participate.

Class details:

There will be a FREE class on Friday, June 18th from 5:15-5:45pm!

The 7-class term will meet on Fridays, June 25th through August 13th from 5:15-5:45pm (no class on Friday, July 2nd due to the 4th of July holiday).
