An Edge, Turn & Pattern

Skating Class

What are Moves in the Field:

MOVES IN THE FIELD - One of the test structures in U.S. Figure Skating (including free skating, dance, etc.). Moves in the field tests help develop all basic fundamental edges and turns while emphasizing edge quality, extension, quickness and power {definition taken from US Figure Skating's website}.

Moves class objective:

This course will concentrate on the new elements and/or new patterns included within the Moves in the Field structure with the goal of improving overall skating ability with focused attention on edges, flow, extension, posture, power, etc.

Skill requirement:

Skaters who have passed Preliminary Moves in the Field and up are eligible to participate.

Class details:

A 30-minute class meeting weekly on Wednesdays from 8:30-9:00am—June 23rd through August 18th— for \$80. No class Wednesday, July 7th due to the holiday.

The \$80 package pricing is offered for the 8 classes only. No refunds or credits for missed classes and there are no make-up classes available.

Skaters may “walk-on” for a \$15 fee per class and must present paid receipt to instructor at the beginning of class.
