**Student Benefits:**

- ◆ Eight Basic 1-8, Freeskate &/or Adult classes for \$119.00.
- ◆ Eight Snowplow classes for \$95.00. Snowplow tuition is reduced as practice ice is not offered for skaters at this beginner level as the focus is on class time.
- ◆ 30 minute lesson once a week (either Tuesday **OR** Saturday).
- ◆ **Two** make-up class opportunities per semester. **Make-up classes may not be taken on the following date: 1/3, 1/7, 2/14, 2/21, 2/18 & 2/25.**
- ◆ Free skate rental for class — please request figure skates, unless enrolled in hockey.
- ◆ Ice House Class Card with 8 free public skate sessions, *skate rental not included*. \$3 public admission after all 8 sessions are used, *skate rental not included during weekend sessions*.
- ◆ \$0.25 soda drinks in eatery & 10% off regularly priced merchandise in the Pro Shop **for student only** with Class Card.
- ◆ US Figure Skating Basic Skills book with stickers (given once), Basic Skills member patch and year patch (given annually).
- ◆ Sports accident insurance.
- ◆ Class Card & benefits expire at end of enrolled term.
- ◆ Refunds (less \$20 administrative fee), for classes not taken, must be requested to Skating Director by week 3. LTS class card must be forfeited in conjunction with the refund request.

**Important Information:**

- ◆ Skating Director reserves the right to combine or cancel classes based on attendance levels.
- ◆ If only one student attends a class, this student will receive a 20-minute lesson (instead of 30 minutes) as this is a private lesson. At the conclusion of the 20-minute lesson, the skater may remain on the ice in their designated class space and practice on their own.
- ◆ All first time enrollees 4 to 5 years old **must** enroll for Snowplow class. All first time enrollees ages 6 and up **must** register for Basic 1. Skaters 15 and up should register for the Adult Workshop.
- ◆ Dress warmly in layers. Wear gloves or mittens and only 1 pair of *long* socks. Skates should fit snugly and be tied or fastened tightly from the toe up.
- ◆ Arrive at least 20 minutes early and, in order to be admitted to class, please present your Class Card each and every week at the Learn to Skate check-in table located in the front lobby. A Class Card, with intact make-up “punches,” must be presented to the Learn to Skate table attendant in order to be admitted to make-up classes. **A maximum of 8 classes may be taken. Make-up classes may be taken week two through week five.**
- ◆ After presenting Class Card to Learn to Skate table attendant for class or make-up, please proceed to the skate rental counter to obtain skates.
- ◆ Snowplow 1, Basic 1 and new Adult skaters meet OFF-ICE near Pro Shop for the first few classes of the semester. **Safety helmets are strongly recommended for these levels.**
- ◆ Practice ice (open to skaters **enrolled** in Basic 1 & higher) is unsupervised practice time for Learn to Skate participants **ONLY**. Making holes in the ice, spirals, camel spins, chasing, racing and/or horseplay are not permitted.

**Class Offerings:**

**Classes for 4-5 year olds:**

**Snowplow Sam classes are for our youngest skaters ages 4-5. Four to five year old skaters who pass all three Snowplow Sam levels progress on to our Snowplow Workshop class. Snowplow skaters who pass all three Snowplow classes and are 6 years old, progress on to Basic 1.**

**Classes for 6–15 year olds:**

**Basic 1-8 classes for skaters between the ages of 6 & 14**

■ **Basic 1 (6 & up)** Tuesday 6:15pm OR Saturday 11:15am

New enrollees 6 years old & up register for Basic 1

■ **Basic 2-8** Tuesday 6:15pm OR Saturday 11:15am

■ **Freeskate Workshop\*** Tuesday 6:15pm OR Saturday 11:15am

Skaters passing Basic 8 may register for Freeskate

**Classes for 15 years & up:**

■ **Adult Workshop\*** Tuesday 6:15pm OR Saturday 11:15am

**Skaters 15 and up register for the Adult Workshop**

\*Freeskate and Adult courses are categorized as “Workshops” meaning that several levels are combined within these classes. Students will be introduced to a variety of skills from within the curriculum and beyond the scope of the curriculum. Within the Workshop environment, instructors rotate amongst pupils providing instruction to small groups or individuals while others work independently.
