



AdvantEdge classes are specialty courses, included in our US Figure Skating Basic Skills Learn to Skate menu, which are designed to supplement group or private lesson instruction through increased ice-time and exposure to technique from a variety of coaches. Coaches will work stroking, edge, turn, jump and spin skills for 30 minutes. The last 15 minutes of class will be combined with our Creative Movement class with students participating in choreography, style and interpretive skill work.

AdvantEdge courses are geared toward skaters looking for an advanced class or looking to compliment private instruction through a group learning opportunity.

We offer two AdvantEdge classes to serve our clients' needs. The Introductory AdvantEdge class is open to skaters who have **passed Basic 4**. This weekly class meets on Saturdays from 10:00-10:45am.

Skaters who demonstrate a solid Loop, Flip, Lutz, backward scratch spin and are at minimum working on the Pre-Pre Moves in the Field test, will be placed in the Advanced AdvantEdge class. This weekly class also meets on Saturdays from 10:00-10:45am.

Group class is an economical way to obtain instruction and increase ice time. It also has the added benefit of providing a social component to an otherwise individualized sport. The goal of this specialty programming is to provide affordable lessons within a group setting while improving skating skills and exposing students to both new maneuvers and different teaching techniques. **The incentive pricing takes into consideration that there are no make-up classes for this offering.**

Due to the popularity of this offering, *class sizes may be large and there is variation of skill set* even within the Introductory and Advanced courses. The curriculum is not designed to help skaters MASTER new skills as consistent, individualized attention is not provided. Please keep in mind, the curriculum is structured to help skaters *improve their overall skating ability* and the focus is not the acquisition of any particular jump, spin or stroking move.

The Skating Director has the right to move any enrollment in order to ensure rosters meet the minimal criteria as outlined above and to afford each skater the most comfortable placement and experience. Please see the Skating Director and/or your private lesson coach with any questions.

Learn to Skate benefits are included together with a class card with five (5) 30-minute freestyle sessions and two (3) complimentary public skate sessions, skate rental not included.
