



Winter 2018 Learn to Skate USA Youth Hockey Classes

**Tuesdays: January 9th-February 27th OR
Saturdays: January 13th-March 3rd**
8 youth hockey classes for \$120

Special Winter Promotion:

Enroll by December 11th and enjoy the \$10 on-line early registration discount PLUS receive a second LTS Class Card with 8 complimentary public session admissions, skate rental not included. This complimentary Class Card will be available for use as of 12/21 so skaters may practice during winter break! The Class Card that is regularly given with tuition will be available on the first class day—either January 9th or January 13th.

Student Benefits:

- ◆ Eight youth hockey classes for \$120. Hockey tuition is offered at this reduced rate as practice ice is not offered on class days for skaters participating in this curriculum.
- ◆ Once registered, class day may only be changed with Skating Director approval and upon payment of a \$15 fee.
- ◆ 30 minute lesson once a week on Tuesdays **OR** Saturdays.
- ◆ **Two** make-up class opportunities per semester. **Make-up classes may not be taken on the first or last class days: 01/09, 01/13, 02/27 or 03/03.** A maximum of 8 classes may be taken this semester.
- ◆ Free skate rental for class — please request hockey skates.
- ◆ Ice House class card with UNLIMITED free public skate sessions, *skate rental not included.* Class card must be presented for complimentary or reduced admission prices and is for enrolled student only.
- ◆ \$0.25 soda drinks in eatery & 10% off regularly priced merchandise in the Pro Shop for student only with class card.
- ◆ Sports accident insurance.
- ◆ Class card and benefits expire at the end of enrolled term.
- ◆ Refunds (less \$20 administrative fee) for classes not taken, must be requested to Skating Director by week 3. LTS class card must be forfeited in conjunction with the refund request.

Important Information:

- ◆ Skating Director reserves the right to combine or cancel classes based on attendance levels. If only one student attends a class, this student will receive a 20 minute lesson (instead of 30 minutes) as this is a private lesson. At the conclusion of the 20-minute lesson, the skater may remain on the ice in their designated class space and practice on their own.
- ◆ There will be no make-up guarantee for classes canceled due to Acts of God and/or mechanical issues.
- ◆ All first time enrollees ages 6 and up **must** register for Hockey 1.
- ◆ Dress warmly in layers. Wear gloves or mittens and only 1 pair of *long* socks. Skates should fit snugly and be tied or fastened tightly from the toe up.
- ◆ Arrive at least 20 minutes early. In order to be admitted to class, class card must be presented each and every week at the Learn to Skate check-in table located in the front lobby. A class card, with intact make-up “punches,” must be presented to the Learn to Skate table attendant in order to be admitted to make-up classes. **A maximum of 8 classes may be taken. Make-up classes may be taken week two through week seven.**
- ◆ After presenting class card to Learn to Skate table attendant for class or make-up, please proceed to the skate rental counter to obtain **hockey** skates.
- ◆ Hockey 1-4 classes meet at the scoreboard end of the rink near locker room 3 and the Visitor’s bench.
- ◆ Hockey equipment is **not** required, but safety helmets are strongly recommended for all hockey students.
- ◆ All elements will be taught without a stick or puck as proper skating technique is the primary focus.

Hockey 1-4 for skaters 6-14 years old:

- ◆ **Hockey 1 Class** ~ new enrollees 6 years & up
- ◆ **Hockey 2-4 Classes** ~ skaters who have passed Hockey 1-3, respectively.

New skaters 4 or 5 years old must register for our Snowplow 1 class and must pass Snowplow 1-4 before enrolling in Hockey 1.

Tuesday classes meet from 5:45pm-6:15pm
Saturday classes meet from 10:45am-11:15am

Hockey 1-4 tuition is \$120

Ask us about participating in the Greensboro Youth Hockey Association’s Learn to Play program upon graduation from Hockey 2.

Safety helmets are recommended for all hockey classes.

The hockey curriculum was developed through a collaborative effort by USA Hockey and Learn to Skate USA. The objectives of Hockey 1-4 are to teach the fundamentals of hockey skating. Skaters will learn the basics necessary for success in future game situations.
