

# Spring 2018 Learn to Skate USA

Classes held Tuesdays ~ March 6th-April 24th OR Saturdays ~ March 10th-April 28th  
\$10 on-line early registration discount through Sunday, March 4th!

## PLEASE NOTE:

There are no classes on Saturday, April 14th as the Greensboro Ice House & Summit Figure Skating Club are hosting the figure skating event of the State Games of North Carolina. Saturday skaters **MUST** make-up the Saturday, April 14th class on any Tuesday within the spring semester (please review block out date information below).

## Student Benefits:

- ◆ Eight Snowplow 1-4, Basic 1 or Adult 1-3 classes for \$120.00. These entry level courses have reduced tuition as practice ice is not offered on the day of class for these participants.
- ◆ Eight Basic 2-6, Pre-Free Skate & Free Skate 1-6 &/or Adult 4-6 classes for \$145.00.
- ◆ Once registered, class day may only be changed with Skating Director approval and upon payment of a \$15 fee.
- ◆ 30 minute lesson once a week (either Tuesday OR Saturday).
- ◆ **Two** make-up class opportunities per semester. Make-up classes may not be taken on the first class days (3/6 & 3/10). Make-up's are typically not permitted on the last class dates, but we've waived that this semester due to State Games and spring break. **A maximum of 8 classes may be taken.**
- ◆ Free skate rental for class — please request figure skates, unless enrolled in hockey.
- ◆ Ice House class card with UNLIMITED free public skating sessions, *skate rental not included*. Class card must be presented for complimentary public skate admission and is for enrolled student only.
- ◆ \$0.25 soda drinks in eatery & 10% off regularly priced merchandise in the Pro Shop for student only with class card.
- ◆ US Figure Skating Basic Skills book (given once upon passing Basic 1 or Adult 1).
- ◆ Sports accident insurance.
- ◆ Class card & benefits expire at the end of enrolled term.
- ◆ Refunds (less \$20 administrative fee) for classes not taken, must be requested to Skating Director by week 3. LTS class card must be forfeited in conjunction with the refund request.

## Important Information:

- ◆ Skating Director reserves the right to combine or cancel classes based on attendance levels. If only one student attends a class, this student will receive a 20-minute lesson (instead of 30 minutes) as this is a private lesson. At the conclusion of the 20-minute lesson, the skater may remain on the ice in their designated class space and practice on their own.
- ◆ There will be no make-up guarantee for classes canceled due to Acts of God and/or mechanical issues.
- ◆ All first time enrollees 4 to 5 years old **must** enroll for our Snowplow 1 class. All first time enrollees ages 6 and up **must** register for Basic 1. All first time enrollees 15 years old and up **must** register for our Adult 1 class.
- ◆ Dress warmly in layers. Wear gloves or mittens and only 1 pair of *long* socks. Skates should fit snugly and be tied or fastened tightly from the toe up.
- ◆ Arrive at least 20 minutes early and, in order to be admitted to class, please present your class card each and every week at the Learn to Skate check-in table located in the front lobby. A class card must be presented to the Learn to Skate table attendant in order to be admitted to make-up classes. **A maximum of 8 classes may be taken. Make-up classes may be taken week two through week eight.**
- ◆ After presenting class card to Learn to Skate table attendant for class or make-up, please proceed to the skate rental counter to obtain skates.
- ◆ Snowplow 1 skaters meet OFF-ICE near Pro Shop for the first few classes of the semester. Basic 1 skaters meet OFF-ICE near the skate rental counter for the first class of the semester & Adult 1 skaters meet OFF-ICE near the eatery for the first class of the semester.
- ◆ Practice ice is open to skaters **enrolled** in Basic 2-6, Pre-Free Skate, Free Skate 1-6 and Adult 4-6 classes. Practice ice takes place the 30 minutes immediately **preceding** class time. Practice ice is unsupervised practice time for Learn to Skate participants **ONLY**.
- ◆ Making holes in the ice, spirals, camel spins, chasing, racing and/or horseplay are not permitted during the designated practice ice time.

### ■ Snowplow 1-4 (4-5 year olds)

New enrollees 4- 5 years old register for Snowplow 1

### ■ Basic 1 (6 & up)

Tuesday 5:45pm OR Saturday 10:45am

New enrollees 6 years old & up register for Basic 1

### ■ Adult 1-3 (15 & up)

Tuesday 5:45pm OR Saturday 10:45am

New enrollees 15 years old & up register for Adult 1

Safety helmets are strongly recommended for all Snowplow classes as well as Basic 1 and Adult 1.

## Advanced Classes \$145:

### ■ Basic 2-6

Tuesday 6:15pm OR

Saturday 11:15am

Basic 2-6 classes are for skaters between the ages of 6 and 14 years old who have passed Basic 1

### ■ Pre-Free Skate & Free Skate 1-6 Workshop\*

Tuesday 6:15pm OR

Saturday 11:15am

Skaters passing Basic 6 may register for Pre-Free Skate

### ■ Adult 4-6 Workshop\*

Tuesday 6:15pm OR

Saturday 11:15am

Skaters 15 years old and up, who have passed Adult 3, may register for the Adult Workshop

\*Pre-Free Skate & Free Skate 1-6, along with Adult 4-6 courses are categorized as "Workshops" meaning that several levels are combined within these classes. Within the Workshop environment, instructors rotate amongst pupils providing instruction to small groups or individuals while others work independently.
